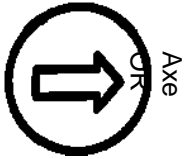
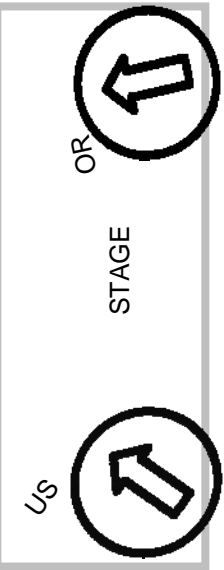
US Flag centers on the stage color team begins marking time then on command turns left if presenting for the anthem, pledge or other and turns right if just going to post still marking time and on command halt.

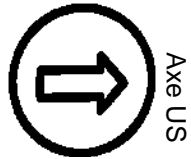
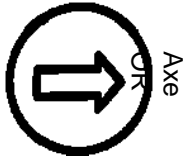
Simple posting

US Flag steps out first turn using no facing movements
State Flag one step behind
Guards stand fast



Simple posting

State Flag sets staff quietly in the base first
National Flag sets the staff in base sharply
to post. US bearer cues both flags to dress,
hands drop together
Guards stand fast



Simple posting

1 second pause, national steps back and State steps and turns at the same time to face the National Flag, 1 second pause and both salute, 2 count up/down.

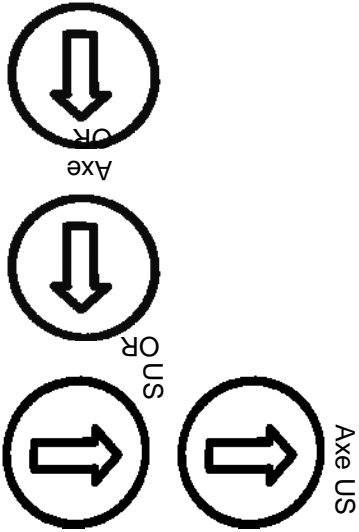

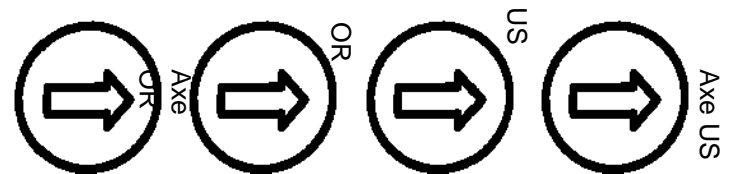

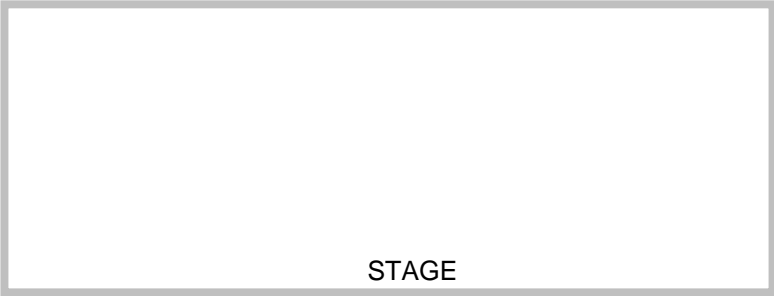
On command team begins marking time turns to Exit on the left and marches off using a column left to the rear of the room and exit.

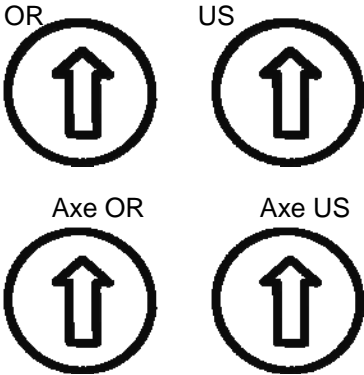

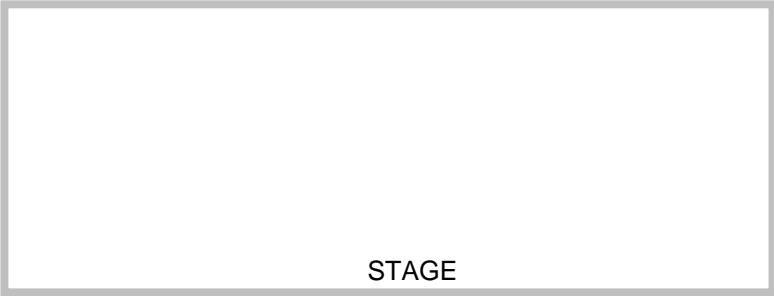
After exit the team comes to a halt on command and is dismissed or falls out to another assignment.



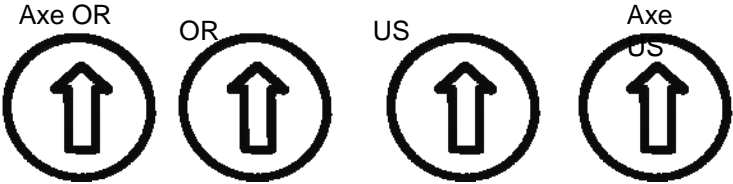


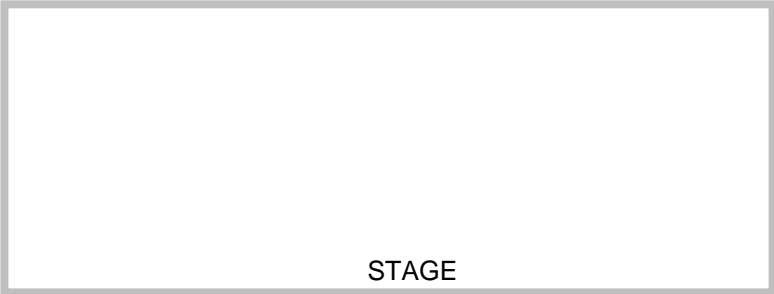

Color Bearers step out and around axes without pause and without facing movements, Guards Stand Fast



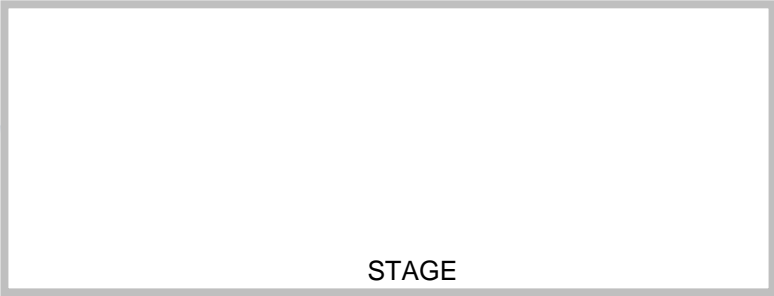
Post

Stand Fast

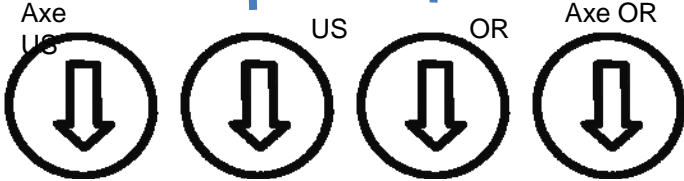
